Personal Items at School

Personal items that are brought from home are not the school's responsibility. Student Safety Patrol

Ms. Mach is our safety patrol coordinator. She has worked with Officer Friendly and our Fifth Grade students who volunteered for these important jobs. Please remind your children that they need to follow the directions of the Patrols for their safety. If you observe any difficulties with patrol members, please call and report it to Ms. Mach.

Adult Crossing Guard

There is an Adult Crossing Guard available on 52nd Street and 35th Avenue as well as on 60th Street and 33rd Avenue. They are there at 7:20 –7:50 and 2:40-3:10. Please ask your children to follow the safety procedures at these crossings. Your children's safety is very important to us!

No Stopping, Standing And Parking Signs.

There is absolutely no parking on the side of the street nearest the school. The police will ticket those who are parking in those spots. They will record license plates and mail tickets through the mail. Please drop students off on the opposite side of the street and have them use the safety patrols to cross the street. Your child's safety is our top priority. We need your help to make this successful.

After School

Please remind your children at home before they leave for school what their afterschool arrangements are. At the end of the day we get many calls asking for the office to deliver messages to students for special arrangements afterschool. Please try to avoid these calls it interrupts instruction in the classroom and tends to distract or confuse the children. It is much better for them to know the plan at the beginning of the day.
