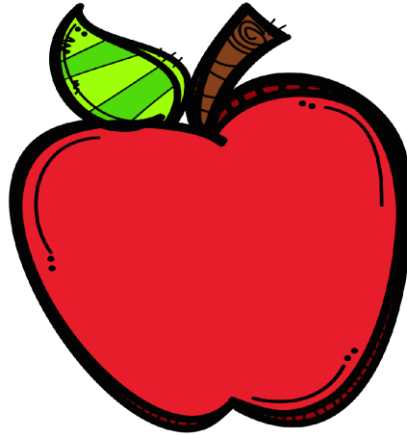


By June 2022, McKinley Elementary will be ranked in the top 5 Title 1 Elementary Schools by building a foundation that focuses on academic growth and character development.

**Homework:**

Read to Succeed information went home on October 26<sup>th</sup>. Please have your student read 6 hours by 2/22/2018 and record time per day (initialed by you) that they've read. A regular time and place for your student to complete homework every night is helpful. On nights they don't have homework, they may want to read a book during the routine time instead. From Mr. Z. "If you are not seeing these words come home with your students each Monday, please check with them on where they are or definitely contact me so we can get your student to start bringing them home to study."

**Reading : Mr. Z is teaching the English Language Arts curriculum for Reading and Spelling.**

Second Quarter Goals Include: Study characters and story elements . Summarize story elements and important details. Analyzing story theme(s). Interpret the author's point of view.

**Writing:** Our writing assignments are taught in their homeroom. Second quarter goals include writing longer, well-organized paragraphs for OPINION WRITING. Students will be making a speech for a Public Service Announcement.

**Math: Mr. Wolf is teaching the Mathematics curriculum.** Second quarter units include topics of Geometry, Division, and Fractions/Decimals/Percents.

**Social Studies and Science:** Mrs. Bohm teaches the Science curriculum which involves Modeling Matter, and Students understand the political, religious, social, and economic institutions that evolved in the colonial era, Students explain the causes of the American Revolution, Students understand the course and consequences of the American Revolution.

**Specials:** We have an A-E schedule, which follows A-Music, B-Art, C-Library, D-Number Talks, and E-Physical Education.
