### **In Reading...**

We are soo excited that we have begun guided reading and your child is reading!! Please make sure your child is reading their book to everyone in the home, sign reading log and return the reading log and book in your child's book bag.

Lessons include; learning sight words, rhyming, letters and their sounds. In read alouds we are identifying characters, sequence of events, and details with many versions of the Gingerbread Man.



### **In Math...**

Your child continues to work on recognizing numbers, counting, measurement by volume, greater than, simple addition with objects or drawings writing numbers and shapes; hexagon, trapezoid, rhombus.



### **In Social Studies...**

Our curriculum for quarter 2 discusses needs and wants. Students will identify what they "need" to survive in life and what they "want". Everyday we learn how to promote a positive school environment through play and group activities.
