**m a t h :** For the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter our objectives in math are measuring by different attributes, such as length, weight and capacity; composing and decomposing numbers 1-10, adding and subtracting with objects or drawing to 5. Students continue to practice printing numbers, recognizing numbers and counting aloud.

**r e a d i n g & w r i t i n g :** Our kindergarten goals within the month of April include students retelling a story in sequence with details, identify the main idea and supporting ideas in fiction and non-fiction stories. Students will also compare and contrast stories.

In writing, we are working on the components of spacing between words, punctuation marks, starting the sentence with a capital letter, using sight words and sounding out unknown words.

**s c i e n c e :** The final science lesson for the year will be discussing and observing weather and sunlight. Students will be weather scientist as we make observations about how the weather is effecting our school playground.
